The tour to Imperial Delhi will include a visit to the Qutub Minar, the tallest stone tower in India. Qutub-ud-din Aibak started building it in 1199. After destroying 27 Hindu and Jain temples Aibak used their columns to erects the attached Quwwat-ul-Islam mosque. Then visit Humayun's tomb, built by the widow of the second Mughal Emperor, Humayun. This tomb is an outstanding monument in the Indo-Persian style, a precursor of the Taj Mahal. The tour also includes a drive past the imposing India Gate, the Parliament building and the Rashtrapati Bhawan, the President's residence.

The area around the Red Fort in North Delhi, is part of the historic city of Shahjahanabad, built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in the 17th Century. Now known as Old Delhi, it remains largely unchanged in its historic ambience and walking through its narrow lanes will take you back to an earlier time. We first visit Rajghat, the memorial of Mahatma Gandhi and National Gandhi Museum. The final stop of the tour is the visit to the Red fort (Lal Qila). It was built during the reign of Emperor Shah Jahan & it was a residence to the royal family.

Swaminarayan Akshardham temple complex in New Delhi epitomizes 10,000 years of Indian culture in all its breathtaking grandeur, beauty, wisdom and bliss. The grand, ancient-styled Swaminarayan Akshardham complex was built in just five years through the blessings of HDH Pramukh Swami Maharaj of the Bochasanwasi Shri Akshar Purushottam Swaminarayan Sanstha (BAPS) and the colossal devotional efforts of 11,000 artisans and BAPS volunteers. The complex was inaugurated on 6th November 2005.

Delhi - Jodhpur - Pushkar - Udaipur – Delhi

Day 01 - Delhi to Jodhpur (By Air)

On time transfer to the domestic airport to connect flight for Jodhpur. Meet & greet at the Jodhpur airport & check into the Hotel. Late afternoon city tour visit to Umaid Bhawan Palace, Jaswant Tada, Clock Tower. Evening free for leisure & overnight at the hotel.

Evening visit to Pushkar Lake is another important attraction of Pushkar and it has immense significance for the followers of Hinduism according to legend the lake was dedicated to Lord Brahma. The lake at Pushkar is called Tirtharaj which means king of all holy places. Most hindu temples. Most Hindu temples have a holy lake of river where devotees are supposed to take a dip to purify themselves before entering the temple.

Day 03 - Pushkar to Udaipur - (Approx 280 km & 4 hours drive)

After morning breakfast, visit to Brahm temple. It is the most important temple in the world where Lord Brahma is worshipped. This temple is the only temple dedicated to Brahma, the Hindu god of creation, four headed facing and all four directions symbolizing his presence everywhere. The temple has marble floors and stairs and coins have been put by the devotees to mark the the births and deaths of their loved ones. Later leave by surface for Udaipur on arrival check into the Hotel. Evening enjoy Boat ride on Lake Pichola & overnight at the hotel.

Day 04 - In Udaipur

After leisurely breakfast, full day Sightseeing Tour of Jagdish Temple, City Palace Museum, Sahelion ki Bari and Walk through the Romantic City Udaipur. Evening at leisure & overnight at the hotel.

Goa is about sunny beaches and moonlit river cruises, whitewashed churches and Hindu temples, old Portuguese houses and beach shacks, carnivals and wildlife, making it a great Incentive Destination. Whether it is chasing dolphins at sunrise, hiring a bike to catch the sunset, cycling past its historic churches, celebrating life with a jazz band; visiting Fort Aguada at night or boarding onto the Casino Cruises.

Day 1 - Take a Flight to Goa from Delhi in the morning. Transfer to the Hotel by Coach. Check in to the Hotel and day at leisure. You have the option of relaxing at the beach and enjoying the vibrant night life of Goa.

Day 2 - Morning enjoy your breakfast and then we proceed for the tour of Old Goa. We will visit the Basilica of Bom Jesus, dedicated to Infant Jesus. An epitome of Baroque architecture, this church has been declared a World Heritage Monument. Basilica of Bom Jesus enshrines the mortal remains of St. Francis Xavier, the patron saint of Goa. On the occasion of 'Exposition,' held once in a decade, St. Francis Xavier's body is displayed for the public.

We also visit the Se Cathedral, one of the largest churches in Asia, the Se Cathedral was dedicated to St. Catherine of Alexandria since the Portuguese led by Alfonso de Albuquerque conquered Goa on the St. Catherine's day (November 25) in 1510. The church contains the Golden Bell used during the infamous Goa Inquisition.

Next we visit, Archaeological Museum set up the Archaeological Museum in the abandoned Convent of St. Francis of Assisi. The 8 galleries of the Archaeological Museum in Old Goa display portraits and sculptures from the prehistoric to the late mediaeval period.

Also we visit the Viceroy's Arch which was built by Viceroy Francisco da Gama, the grandson of Vasco da Gama. A statue of Vasco da Gama, resplendent in his royal uniform, can be seen on top of the arch. Built of laterite stone, the original arch collapsed in 1948 and it was subsequently restored in 1954. Tradition has it that on taking office, all viceroys made the procession under the arch where they would be given the ceremonial key to the city and Goa.

Day 3 - Day is free for leisure. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 4 - Morning at leisure for time at the beach. Later in the afternoon we proceed for the Airport transfer by Coach.
